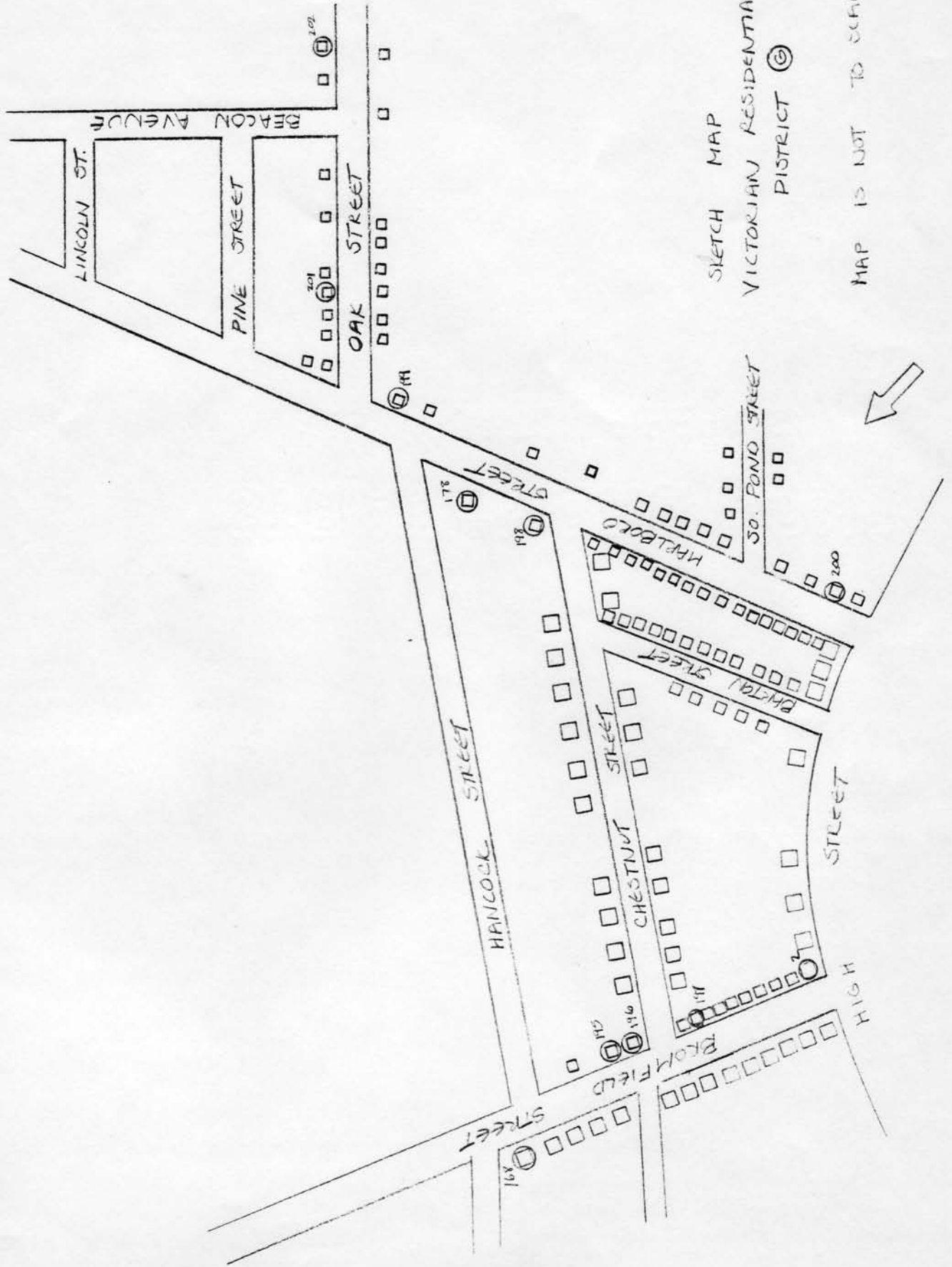
HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE (CONTINUED)

in this century.

The dwellings on Chestnut Street were built to house the factory workers between 1885 and 1900. Several, specifically those on the even side of the street were clearly speculative in nature, generally two family homes of two and a half stories with pitched roof and little if any architectural ornament.

The residents of the Victorian residential district were either skilled craftsman like carpenters or people associated with the shoe or the comb-making industries. The few industrial structures that once stood in this area have been destroyed. The area remains an excellent example of a late nineteenth century middle class residential district.
